Deer Ettner Sex Dates: A day when numbers may narvest eitner antiered or antieriess deer. If it is NOT an ETTHER SEX DAY, numbers may only narvest antiered deer in general firearms tr

In training areas designated as ARCHERY ONLY & SHOTGUN/MUZZLELOADER/ARCHERY ONLY you may harvest deer of either sex throughout the entire deer season.

- a. Alligator hunters must use hand-held ropes or snares, snatch hooks, harpoons, gigs or arrows with a restraining line attached. Alligators must be dispatched immediately upon capture by using a hands in or bands lick or by severing the spinal cord with a sharp implement
- handgun or bangstick, or by severing the spinal cord with a sharp implement.
- b. Alligators on Fort Stewart may only be harvested by individuals who were successful in the iSportsman Zone 8A lottery drawing. Zone 8A alligator tags count toward your statewide bag limit of one. Alligators must have an overall length of 4 feet or greater to be legally harvested.

d. Hunters may take a season total of 5 deer. No more than 3 may be antlerless deer and no more than 2 may be antlered bucks, one of which must have four points on one side at least 1 inch in length.

- Exception: Both bucks must meet the 4 points on 1 side antler restriction in the Quality Deer Management Area (ENTIRE E AND F AREAS). The GA DNR 15 inch minimum outside spread rule DOES NOT APPLY ON FSGA/HAAF.
- e. The 12 Jan. 31 Jan. Extended Archery season is for **Hunter Army Airfield only**.

c. Youth-only firearms days are not authorized during the 11 Oct. - 17 Oct. Primitive Weapons season.

- f. Turkeys harvested on Fort Stewart-Hunter Army Airfield count against your GA ststewide bag limit of 2 birds.
- g. Managed dove fields will be open for dove hunting Saturdays, Sundays, Wednesdays, & Federal holidays. Dove hunters must be checked into field to legally hunt in dove fields. Legal shooting hours for doves are 30 minutes prior to sunrise until sunset.
- h. Legal shooting hours for hunting all furbearers, feral hogs, and coyotes are 30 minutes prior to sunrise until 30 minutes after sunset.
- i. The use of dogs to pursue and take feral hogs, coyotes, foxes, and raccoons (or any other furbearer) is prohibited.
- h. The 15-16 Nov. waterfowl hunting dates are only for Active Duty Military, Veterans, and their youth dependants.
- i. Duck Species Daily Bag Limits: 1 Black or Mottled Duck, 2 Canvasback, 1 Fulvous Whistling Duck, 2 Mallards (only 1 may be a hen), 1 Pintail, 2 Redheads,
- 1 Scaup, 3 Wood Ducks, 2 Hooded Mergansers.
